**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** For the safety of students exiting and boarding school buses, the bus lane (circular drive at the north end of the school) is **CLOSED TO ALL** traffic except school buses from 7:30 – 8:00 am and 2:00 – 3:00 pm. **ALL STUDENTS** parking in a Bloomington North parking lot are required to have a parking permit clearly displayed from their vehicle's rear view mirror. As of Tuesday September 1, security will begin issuing tickets to those vehicles without a permit displayed. A student will receive two warning tickets before their vehicle is towed. On the third offense, the vehicle will be towed, at the owner's expense. Bloomington North issues parking permits for the safety and welfare of its students. This is the only system administrators have to control who parks in school lots. In addition, should something happen to your child's vehicle or should they leave their lights on (...or get out, lock the doors & leave the engine running...it's happened!!!!) the only method school officials have to determine who the vehicle belongs to, is by permit number.
