IMPORTANT ADVANCED PLACEMENT ANNOUNCEMENT:

Dear AP Parents and Students:

AP exam sign up and payment will run from Monday, February 20-Friday, February 24, 2012. You may pay at the bookstore before school, during lunch, or after school with cash or via check made out to Bloomington High School North. The cost of all science and math AP exams is \$13 per exam (because Indiana is sponsoring a portion of the cost). The cost of all other exams is \$100 per exam. Free or Reduced Lunch students may take AP exams at no cost but must verify their status when signing up for exams at the bookstore.

Late AP exam sign up and payment will run from Monday, February 27-Friday, March 2, 2012. An additional \$5 late fee will be added to each exam cost during this week. Absolutely NO exams may be ordered after Friday, March 2, 2012!

- ALL students who wish to take an AP exam MUST come to one of three pre-administration sessions in the BHSN large group room (LGI):

- *7-8am Monday, April 23, 2012
- *2:45-3:45pm Wednesday, April 25, 2012
- *7-8am Friday, April 27, 2012

NO pre-administrations will be allowed after Friday, April 27, 2012!

- AP exams will take place (Monday, May 7-Friday, May 16). Please go to the AP website for parents and students to find out more at: www.collegeboard.com/apstudents

IMPORTANT: Students taking morning AP exams MUST arrive and be seated no later than 7:30am. Students taking afternoon AP exams MUST arrive no later than 11:30am. Locations and other specific information for testing will be available soon on the North website and displayed in each AP classroom.
